- Unified environment:
  - Bringing an IDE (could be eclipse based)
  - Should result in the same behavior wherever built or run
- Interworking open source release
  - Bundle tools that support the same version of the standard and intermediate programming language
  - Include the sources of the contained tools and test suites
  - Include release notes that clarify what interworking in this release means
